DDL utilizes Early Season Ratings (ESL) available on July 15, 2015

Looking for something new in Dallas Men's Tennis? JOIN DDL!

Why DDL?

- (1) ONLY 2 LINES OF DOUBLES
- (2) FULL 2 of 3 SETS (NO 10 POINT TIEBREAKER)
- (3) The method for awarding points in order to determine the winning team of the local league team match and the winner of the local league competition will be (1) Sets Won
 - (2) Head 2 Head
 - (3) Games Won
- (4) The Dallas Double League will be a **Non-NTRP (NR) impacting league.**
- (5) Dallas Doubles League fee: **\$25.00** (The DTA does not refund player league fees unless the level entered does not make).
- (6) Dallas Doubles League is a Non-Advancing Men's League

Levels of DDL play?

Men's Saturday League – 4.0 and 5.0 (5-6 weeks tentatively)

Men's Sunday League – 3.5 and 4.5 (5-6 weeks tentatively)

NOTE! League plays on OPPOSITE day of the 2016 18+ ADULT Fall league.

When will DDL play?

Men's Saturday League (NTRP 4.0 and 5.0) will begin play Saturday, September 19, 2015

Men's Sunday League (NTRP 3.5 and 4.5) will begin play Sunday, September 20, 2015

Team Numbers:

To request a Team Numbers, please email leagues@dta.org with the following information:

- (1) Facility Name, (2) Level, (3) Captain's Name and USTA #

Skeletal rosters (minimum of 4 players) are due on TENNIS LINK no later than Wednesday, August 19, 2015 to be included on schedule. Season will run approximately 5-6 weeks depending on team registration numbers by level. A player must be 18 years old by December 31, 2016. Teams may add players up until one (1) week prior to final match. Players must play once (1) during the regular season to be eligible to advance to CHAMPIONSHIP play.

2016 Dallas Doubles League will offer an end of season CHAMPIONSHIP if registration numbers by level on Wednesday, August 19, 2015 warrant. Dates will be determined at that time.

Player Registration:

Player registration is online at the TENNIS LINK website at <http://tennislink.usta.com/leagues>. Once on the TENNIS LINK Leagues website, click on “Register for a team” and enter your USTA number and the team number. Follow the prompts through the credit card portion. Once you have successfully completed registration you will receive a screen notification and an e-mail confirmation.
