**2023 18 & over ADULT M. Fall League -
Post Season Advancement**
CITY CHAMPIONSHIP 11/17-20, 2022

2023 Dallas 18+ ADULT Fall League CITY CHAMPIONSHIP format will be 2-Singles and 3-Doubles. Exception W2.5, M3.0, 5.0 and OPEN will be 1-Singles and 2-Doubles.

NOTES:

1. 2023 USTA Dallas 18 & over ADULT Fall League is Non-Advancing (NO Sectionals or Nationals). FALL CHAMPIONS will be awarded a Wild Card in to 2023 USTA Dallas 18 & over ADULT Spring/Summer (S/S) League Play Offs in July 2023 if Spring/Summer team as 50% or at least 8 players from the 18 & over ADULT Fall roster registered by S/S roster deadline. Wild Card is only good if returning to same NTRP level of play in the 2023 USTA Dallas 18 & over ADULT S/S League.
2. The 2023 USTA Dallas 18 & over ADULT Fall League CITY CHAMPIONSHIP play will begin on Thursday, 11/17, 2022 evening for select NTRP Levels. **PLEASE NOTIFY PLAYERS SO THAT EVERYONE IS PREPARED.**
3. DTA and your fellow captains are expecting to play all 4 lines (3 lines for NTRP W2.5, M3.0 and 5.0) throughout post season play, including League Play Offs and City Championship. Should your team accept their playoff spot and then default 2 or more lines over the entire City Championship, your team may be subject to potential disciplinary actions to be determined by the Post Season Grievance Committee. For W2.5, M3.0 and 5.0, if team defaults 2 lines or more over the entire City Championship, your team may be subject to potential disciplinary actions to be determined by the Post Season Grievance Committee. DTA's goal is to host Post Season Play. However, if faced with inclement weather, as the event organizer the DTA maintains the right to alter post season play (i.e. number of advancing teams, format, etc...) or possibly even cancellation.

2023 USTA Dallas Rules and Regulations:

2C(1). All players with a valid computer rating must play two (2) matches during the local league season (one (1) of which may be a default) in all leagues other than 55 & Over MIXED, Combo Doubles and Tri Level which require only one (1) match (zero defaults) to be eligible to participate in championship competition (Local League Championship, Sectionals, etc...).

2C(2). All Self-Rated and Valid Computer Rated Appealed players must play three (3) matches during the local league season (zero defaults) in all leagues other than 55 & Over MIXED, Combo Doubles and Tri Level which require only one (1) match (zero defaults) to be eligible to participate in championship competition (Local League Championship, Sectionals, etc...).

M3.0 – 17 Teams

1 flight of 9, Round Robin (8 matches) and 1 flight of 8, Round Robin (7 matches)

Flight A Regular Season Ends 10/29/2022; Flight B Regular Season Ends 10/22/2022

CITIES:

Advancement: 2 - 1st Place Teams and 2 – 2nd Place Teams

Format: 1st Place Flight A vs. 2nd Place Flight B; 1st Place Flight B vs. 2nd Place Flight A; Winners advance to FINAL

M3.5 – 30 Teams

3 flights of 10 teams (9 matches)

Regular Season Ends 11/6/2022

CITIES:

Advancement: 3 - 1st Place Teams, 3 – 2nd Place Teams and 2 – 3rd Place Teams with the Best Overall Record

Format: 2 Flights of 4 Teams - Round Robin; Winners advance to FINAL

M4.0 – 36 Teams

4 flights of 9 teams, Round Robin (8 matches)

Regular Season Ends 11/5/2022

CITIES:

Advancement: 4 - 1st Place Teams, 4 – 2nd Place Teams

Format: 2 Flights of 4 Teams – Round Robin; Winners advance to FINAL

M4.5 – 16 Teams

2 flights of 8 teams, Round Robin (7 matches)

Regular Season Ends 10/23/2022

CITIES:

Advancement: 2 - 1st Place Teams and 2 – 2nd Place Teams

Format: 1st Place Flight A vs. 2nd Place Flight B; 1st Place Flight B vs. 2nd Place Flight A; Winners advance to FINAL

M5.0 – 8 Teams

Single flight of 8 teams, Round Robin (7 matches)

Regular Season Ends 10/22/2022

CITIES:

Advancement: 1st through 3rd Place teams

Format: 2nd Place Team vs. 3rd Place Team; Winner vs. 1st Place Team
