### Team Numbers Available and Player Registration Open

Player Registration closes on Tuesday, 4/18/2023 at 10:59pm, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Schedule will publish Wednesday, 4/12/2023.

**Levels:** 6.0, 7.0, 8.0 and 9.0

***IMPORTANT!*** Team counts will be capped at four (4) teams for NTRP 6.0 and 9.0 unless registration number dictate otherwise; eight (8) teams for NTRP 7.0 and 8.0. Number of matches will be determined based on team count by NTRP Level at Roster Deadline. Teams may tentatively plan 4-5 matches depending on how far an individual team advances in the Weekend Event.

**Format:** 3 lines of doubles

**Guidelines:** The NTRP difference between members of an individual doubles pair may not exceed 1.0. Leagues must have at least a two (2) team league locally to advance to Sectionals. Teams may have only one (1) player from outside the 50-mile radius of the center of Dallas. A RETIREMENT shall count as a qualifying match for all players involved.

#### **Texas Section League Rule Revision!**

Players will be allowed to play on more than one team at different NTRP levels during Section Championship. This will include Local League Post Season Play to include League Play Offs and City Championships.

#### **2023 DALLAS TENNIS USTA Rules and Regulations:**

**2C.** All players with a valid computer rating must play two (2) matches during the local league season in all leagues other than 55 & Over MIXED, Combo Doubles and Tri Level which require only one (1) match to be eligible to participate in championship competition (Local League Championship, Sectionals, etc...).

**2D.** In the Adult and Mixed Divisions, all players other than Self-Rated and Valid Computer Rated Appealed Players are eligible to advance to National Championship competition if that player has played on the same team in at least three (3) matches at the same NTRP level in the same Age Group through Sectional Championships and is otherwise eligible. A maximum of one (1) default received by the player during local league or championship competition shall count for advancing.

Eligibility to advance to National Championships for self-rated and computer-rated appealed players requires playing at least four (4) matches on the same team at the same level in the same Age Group. No defaults received count.

#### **2022 Sectional Rule! Local League to follow.**

Self-rate and computer rated appealed players will need three (3) matches, zero (0) defaults to be eligible to participate in championship competition (Local League Championship, Sectionals, etc...).

**2023 USTA**

**TEXAS Rules and Regulations:**

A team may have only one (1) player from outside the 50-mile radius of the center of a large city, Fort Worth, Dallas, San Antonio, Austin and Houston... If a player does not have the specific league in one of our designated areas (i.e. Abilene, Amarillo, Austin), he/she can play in another city without it counting as part of the out of city maximum.

**Cost: \$40.00/player** (includes a non-refundable Active.com processing fee of \$3.00). Non-refundable unless level DOES NOT make. Player must be a USTA member. Visit <http://tennislink.usta.com/leagues> (no www) or call USTA @ 1-800-990-8782.
