6/13/2022 Request a Team Number; Player Registration Opens

2023 Fall Winners receive a **Wild Card** to the 2023 USTA Dallas 18 & over ADULT Spring/Summer (S/S) League Playoffs (QT) in July 2023. 2023 USTA Dallas 18 & over ADULT S/S roster must have 50% of the winning Fall roster or at least 8 players from the Fall roster registered on TENNIS LINK by registration deadline to qualify for Wild Card.

2023 Fall Wild Card Winners must compile with the 2022 USTA Dallas Rules and Regulations:

2C(1). All players with a valid computer rating must play two (2) matches during the local league season (one (1) of which may be a default) in all leagues other than 55 & Over MIXED, Combo Doubles and Tri Level which require only one (1) match (zero defaults) to be eligible to participate in championship competition (Local League Championship, Sectionals, etc...).

2C(2). All Self-Rated and Valid Computer Rated Appealed players must play three (3) matches during the local league season (zero defaults) in all leagues other than 55 & Over MIXED, Combo Doubles and Tri Level which require only one (1) match (zero defaults) to be eligible to participate in championship competition (Local League Championship, Sectionals, etc...).

2D. In the Adult and Mixed Divisions, all players other than Self-Rated and Valid Computer Rated Appealed Players are eligible to advance to National Championship competition if that player has played on the same team in at least three (3) matches at the same NTRP level in the same Age Group through Sectional Championships and is otherwise eligible. A maximum of one (1) default received by the player during local league or championship competition shall count for advancing.

All Self-Rated and Valid Computer Rated Appealed players are eligible to progress to National Championship competition if that player has played on the same team in at least four (4) matches at the same NTRP level in the same AGE Group during its local league season and is otherwise eligible. No defaults received by the player during local league or championship competition shall count for advancing. Retired matches shall count toward advancing for all players involved in both USTA League Divisions.

Men's Non-NTRP Impacting Saturday League (NTRP 3.0, 4.0 and 5.0) will begin play Saturday, 9/10/2022

Men's Non-NTRP Impacting Sunday League (NTRP 3.5, 4.5 and OPEN) will begin play Sunday, 9/11/2022

Format:

Women's Weekday:

1 – Singles; 3 – Doubles (NTRP 3.0, 3.5, 4.0 and 4.5)

1 – Singles; 2 – Doubles (NTRP W2.5, M3.0, 5.0 and OPEN)

Women's Weekend and Men's:

2 – Singles; 3 – Doubles (NTRP 3.0, 3.5, 4.0 and 4.5)

1 – Singles; 2 – Doubles (NTRP W2.5, M3.0, 5.0 and OPEN)

NOTE!!!! 2023 Dallas 18+ ADULT Fall League CITY CHAMPIONSHIP format will be 2-Singles and 3-Doubles.

Weeks of play will be determined after the roster deadline noted above and number of teams by NTRP level set. The DTA's goal is to schedule 8-10 weeks of play during the regular season.

Skeletal rosters minimum of 8 players (5 players NTRP W2.5, M3.0 and 5.0+) are due on TENNIS LINK no later than Monday, 7/11/2022 to be included on schedule. 7 players for W. Weekday League (5 players NTRP W2.5, M3.0 and 5.0+).

Teams may continue to add players up until 2 weeks/3 weeks for Self-rate and Computer Appeal players prior to the final regular season match.

Player Registration:

Player registration is online at the TENNIS LINK website at <http://tennislink.usta.com/leagues>. Once on the TENNIS LINK Leagues website, click on "Register for a team" and enter your USTA number and the team number. Follow the prompts through the credit card portion. Once you have successfully completed registration you will receive a screen notification and an e-mail confirmation.
