Important Dates:

February 9 – Team Number Requests and Registration open

February 21 – Minimum Roster due

March 29 – Schedules published

April 11-12 – Spring/Summer League begins (Saturday: 3.5, 4.5 Open; Sunday: 3.0, 4.0, 5.0)

July 9-12 – City Championships

August 7-9/14-16 – Sectionals (0's/.5's)

Format:

2 Singles, 3 Doubles (3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5)

1 Singles, 2 Doubles (5.0, Open)

Fees:

\$37 + TennisLink fees (note: league fees are non-refundable)

Rule Reminders:

- **51% of your team must be playing at level.** Players may play up one NTRP level, but the majority of the team needs to be rated at the level you are playing.
- A team may only have one player residing outside the 50-mile radius of Dallas.
- A player may play on more than one team within a division in the same season provided the teams are in different NTRP levels.
- Move-up/Split-up: (from the USTA National Regulations)

2.06A(1): Move-Up – Teams and team members that advanced to, or qualified for, any National Championship may play together as a team, in whole or in part, if they move up one NTRP team level.

2.06A(2): Split-Up – No more than three (3) players who were on the roster of any team that advanced to, or qualified for, any National Championship team the previous year may play together in the same Division, same Age Group and at the same NTRP team level as the National Championship team(s), if their NTRP rating allows. Split-Up requirements only apply to all players other than Self-Rated and Valid Computer Rated Appealed Players who participated in three (3) or

more matches (one default received shall count) and Self-Rated and Valid Computer RatedAppealed players who participated in at least four (4) matches (no default received shall count), for that team during the championship year.

- A player who has qualified for Sectionals with a team from another local league is not eligible to participate in USTA Dallas City Championships in the same division/NTRP level.

Playoffs:

Playoff details will be sent at a later date. Single flight leagues that play multiple round robins will not have a playoff. Single flight, single round robin leagues will have a single-elimination playoff with the top 3 teams. Multi-flight leagues will play a round robin playoff format. (Formats are subject to change.)
